The event included talks by Peter Davies from Thales on 'Cyber Security of Complex Systems that Matter: a view from the IT and Defence Industry.'

There was also a talk by Tania Wallis and Chris Johnson from Glasgow University on 'the NIS Directive and Supply Chain Resilience', Ola Michalec from the University of Bristol on 'Cyber security cultures in Critical National Infrastructures', and Richard Thomas of Birmingham University on 'ICS Vulnerabilities happen... what lessons can we learn?'

These talks highlighted that the RITICS projects are beginning to make progress, and we hope to see further research findings in forthcoming meetings.
